




LOCATION AND VENUES


Lappi-Areena

instructor-led activities will be organised for children every day.

Activitities are always supervised and instructed by

trained staff. Instruction will be offered in Finnish, English and Swedish (varying by location and activity).

Activities will include:

- skiing lessons
- indoor sport activities
- adventure activities (wall climbing, abseiling, snow shoeing, etc.)
- visits to local attractions

All children events apart from Nicholas Cup are open to all children participating the Winter Games as a competitor or as an accompanying junior.



ACCOMMODATION

Luxury cabins


Ounasvaaran Lakituvat cabins are located in Rovaniemi, on top of the Ounasvaara fell, at the Arctic Circle.

Cabin are in the middle of a network of cross country ski tracks and ski slopes are only 200 metres away.

Luxuriously equipped 67 square meter (721 ft², 80 yd²) apartments have two bedrooms, fully equipped kitchen, living room, bath and the Sauna is always ready. TV, Radio with CD player, Sony Play Station 2 and fast internet access are located in every unit. The cabins offer privacy for four person and limited privacy for two persons accommodated to second floor balcony.

SantaSport training facilities, spa and therapeutic services are within few minutes way from the cabins.





SantaSport - Sport institute


SantaSport offers single, double, three and four person room. All rooms have a toilet, shower, television and central radio. Rooms are clustered around lounges where athletes can socialise with other teams.

If accommodation in SantaSport, all training facilities, spa, therapeutic services are only metres away and available all day, every day.

THE ARCTIC CIRCLE


The Arctic Circle defines the borders of day and night in Lappish summer and winter. During the winter months, during the time of "Kaamos" (winternights), the sun stays below the horizon and almost an endless night continues until spring lifts the sun back up into the sky. The contrast of summer is striking as the midnight sun shines over the vast Lappish landscape.

The Arctic Circle offers plenty of leasure time activities from snow shoe walking to huski-safaries and snowmobile rides. The athmosphere of Lapland can be discovered by visiting Arktikum, a historical museum of Lapland and Lappish people.
